Rules

Bermuda Basketball League – Summer 2018

TEAMS:

All teams must have a Coach and/or Representative

League Fee: \$850.00 (Due no later than June 2nd 2018 for ALL Teams)

BBA Membership Fee: \$25.00 (Due no later than June 2nd 2018for Players, Coaches, Team representatives & Executive)

Uniforms provided by BBL and must be handed in at the end of every game

T-shirts may be worn but must be the same colours of the team jersey

In an effort to work with our sponsor, players are asked to try to abstain from wearing **RED**during game times—Not sure if we should include this clause considering there's a red team again sigh

Up to, but not exceeding, 12 players may be uniformed during games

Players are allowed to transfer teamsonce (1) but are locked into teams after playing 3 games. Notice must be given to both coaches and the BBL Summer league Commissioner for reviewby the League Committee. (Note: The transfer deadline is scheduled for the end of Week 5(<u>June 10th 2017 – SEE LEAGUE SCHEDULE</u>). All players are locked into their teams after this point and no exceptions will be made)

Expected to adhere to BBA Code of Conduct (Found on www.bermudabasketball.net)

Dunking in pregame warm-ups is allowed but no hanging on the rim.

ROSTERS:

All teams have up to a 12 player roster. Roster Submissions due no later than Sunday, May 6th 2018

CONDUCT:

PLAYERS:

Technical fouls, Intentional/flagrant fouls Disorderly Conduct (examples: Vulgar and explicit outbursts, Threatening posture, Insubordination, etc) are punishable by technical foul or suspension. Intentional/flagrant fouls & Disorderly conduct will be determined after discussion with referee, League Commissioner(s) and League Committee.

REFEREES:

Disorderly Conduct by referees will also not be permitted (examples: Vulgar and explicit outbursts, Threatening posture, engaging in an exchange of verbiage with a player or coach without using professionalism or discretion and managing the game fairly without bias toward a player or team). Disorderly conduct is punishable by suspension which will be determined after discussion with the team representative(s) who filed the complaint, League Commissioner(s) and League Committee.

Rules:

Games will consist of 4 x 10 minute quarters.

Clock stops only on FREE THROWS and TIME OUTS.

24 second shot clock

1:30 break in between quarters

2 time outs in the first half, 3 in second half. 1 in overtime if needed. Time outs do not carry over to halves.

Timeouts come from the bench

No live ball timeouts: Non scoring team may call a timeout after they get scored on.

Both teams can call a time out if: after the last free throw, ball is dead out of bounds.

No timeout will be granted if ball is in players hands.

A time-out shall not be permitted to the scoring team when the game clock shows 2:00 minutes or less in the fourth period and in each extra period and, following a successful field goal unless an official has interrupted the game.

Goaltending off the rim is allowed.

8 seconds to break the timeline (half line)

On 5th team foul per quarter there will be a 2 shot penalty. (no more 1 and 1).

Team fouls get reset every quarter.

Once ball is advanced it cannot come backcourt ie on inbounds plays.

Warm-Ups: 10 minutes pregame warm-up from set time of each game. 5 minutes halftime warm-up.

Optional additional 5 minutes time allotted for team without 5 players at official start time before forfeiture.

In the event of overtime, 5 minutes will be added per overtime period.

2 referees

1 scorekeeper

1 timekeeper

SEASON:

14 season games

Single elimination playoffs and finals

(Note: In order for a player to be eligible to play in the playoffs, the player must have played in at least 3 season games. Any team using a player who has not met the criteria will be given a forfeit for that game)
